Inmate Steven Farber Dies

(LINCOLN, Neb.) Steven Farber (52) inmate #57691 died at 1:37 AM on Sunday, September 22, 2013. Farber was assigned to the Lincoln Correctional Center and was serving 26 to 36 years for Robbery and Use of Deadly Weapon to Commit a Felony from Douglas County and Attempted Robbery and Use of a Deadly Weapon to Commit a Felony from Lancaster County. His sentence began on October 21, 2002, and he had a projected release date of April 25, 2019.



Farber had been found unresponsive in his cell on Friday, September 20, 2013, at approximately 11:20 AM. Staff initiated CPR and continued until Emergency Responders arrived. Farber was transported to a local hospital where he remained until his death. The cause of death has yet to be determined.

As is the case whenever an inmate dies in custody of the Department of Correctional Services, a Grand Jury will conduct an investigation.
