

Notice of Public Hearing


The Nebraska Department of Correctional Services (NDCS) will hold a rule-making hearing pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §84-807 at 9 am on the 24th day of June, 2016 to be held at the NDCS Central Office located at 801 W. Prospector Place, Building 1, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509.

The purpose of the hearing is to take testimony and evidence about the adoption of Title 72, Chapter 3, entitled Restitution. This action is proposed to implement Neb. Rev. Stat. §83-184.01 consistent with the authority granted by law and with constitutionality. The subject matter and scope of the rule-making action is the process for collecting and remitting restitution from inmates sentenced to the Department of Correctional Services.

The rules set out the process for collecting restitution from individuals who are orders to pay restitution as part of their sentencing order, establishes the percentage of funds to be collected for restitution, establishes a priority for court ordered payments, a process for remitting restitution collected to the courts and reporting requirements.

Draft or working copies of the proposed rules are available at the offices of the Secretary of State, Regulations Division, Room 343, State Capitol, Lincoln, NE 68509. There is no expected fiscal impact from adopting these regulations.

All interested persons are invited to attend and testify orally or by written submission at the hearing. Interested persons may also submit written comments prior to the hearing which will be made part of the hearing record if received by NDCS on or before June 20, 2016.
